The Frankfurt Book Fair, the largest trade fair for books globally, further enhances the city’s international reputation. With a population of around 750,000 people in the city proper and a metropolitan population exceeding 5.5 million, Frankfurt continues to be a vital European metropolis, combining economic power with cultural influence.
